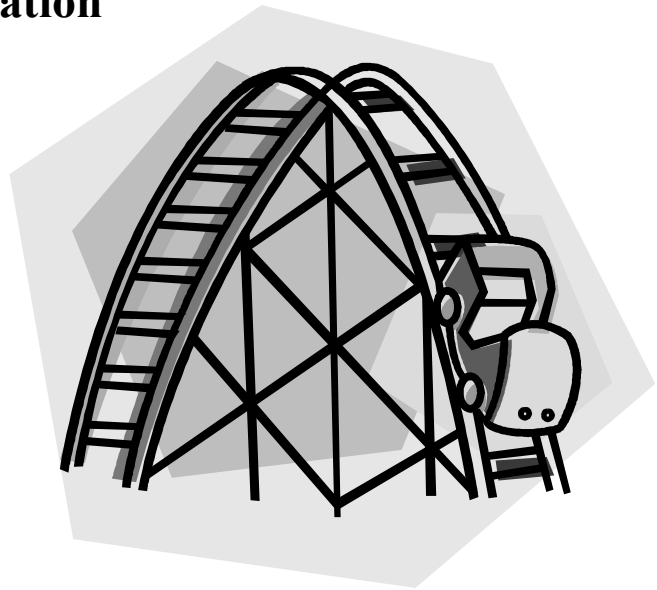

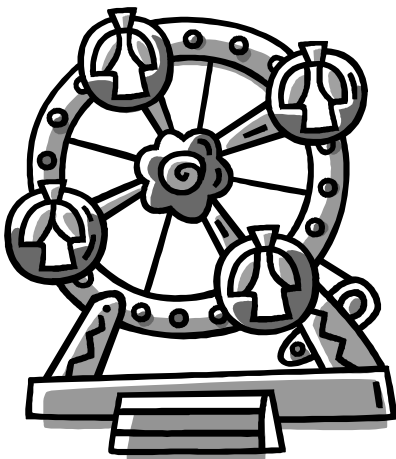
What to Bring:
