

Third Wavers: Hendrix Feminist Club Bylaws and Constitution

Article 1: Name

- A. The official name of this organization shall be Third Wavers: Hendrix Feminist Club, herein after referred to as 3rd Wavers.

Article II: Purpose and Objectives

- A. The purpose of 3rd Wavers will be to promote awareness of and action for gender issues.
- B. 3rd Wavers shall have the following objectives:
 - 1. To be socially and politically involved on campus and in the community.
 - 2. To address issues around campus relating to gender/sex.
 - 3. To provide programming that involves insight into issues of interest to 3rd Wavers
 - 4. To promote healthy body image and body awareness.
 - 5. To promote a better understanding of feminism
 - 6. To provide a forum to discuss feminism and gender issues.

Article III: Membership

- A. Membership shall be open to anyone provided they attend at least one meeting.
- B. All Hendrix students shall be eligible to vote and hold office.

Article IV: Officers

- A. Three to five 3rd Wave members will be elected as officers at the beginning of the academic year or whenever needed as decided by the group. They will distribute their leadership into needed committees which will ultimately be controlled by the participants themselves.

Article V: Election of Officers

- A. Three officers shall be elected in May of each school year.
- B. Two officers shall be elected in August or September of each school year
- C. If, for any reason, an officer is unable to hold office, selection of a replacement shall be made by the club as a whole.

Article VI: Meetings

- A. General meetings shall be held monthly or when determined as necessary. Time and location shall be designated by the officers with input from the general club.
- B. Committee chair meetings shall be held before every general meeting. Time and location shall be designated by the committee.

Article VII: Finance

- A. Finance decisions shall be left to the discretion of the organization as a whole.
- B. 3rd Wavers will attempt to obtain income through the Student Senate Budget and fund-raising activities.

Article VIII: Amendments

- A. These bylaws and constitution may be amended at any general meeting by a two-thirds vote of the members present.
