The College will accept either the SAT Reasoning Test or the ACT with optional Writing Test. Hendrix College shows no preference on which test or version is taken, but we strongly encourage all applicants to take one of the tests during their senior year.

SAT: Hendrix will focus on the Critical Reading and Math sections. The College will continue to cross scores from different test dates.

ACT: Hendrix will focus on the English, Math, Reading, and Science sections. The College will continue to cross scores from different test dates.
