

Health Sciences Major (HESC) Cycle of Assessment

Year 1: Learning goal 3 will be assessed through the *Career Fair activity* and senior dinner, from which information about professional competencies will be gathered. Written and communication skills will be assessed from the assignments described above in Senior Seminar.

- **Year 2:** Learning goal 4 will be assessed from the capstone paper and presentation, and feedback gathered from the senior dinner.
- **Year 3:** Learning goal 1 will be assessed with the capstone exam.
- **Year 4:** Learning goal 2 will be assessed through the paper and presentation in Senior Seminar, and by evaluation of reflective writing from internships.
