

Interdisciplinary Majors – 2019-2020 Assessment Report

The Interdisciplinary Major program recently adopted new learning goals (see below) and a new SAP with new direct and new indirect assessment tools.

Next year, we plan to do the following:

- Present a policy change to the Faculty to require the two additional, more specific, learning goals based on the INTE major proposal.
- Inform Faculty currently involved in existing INTE majors about the need to schedule direct assessment meetings with their students.
- Conduct both the direct assessments with the Faculty and indirect assessments with the Associate Provost for graduating seniors with INTE majors.

Learning Goals

Students earning an interdisciplinary major at Hendrix will:

- 1) Cultivate knowledge of and meaningful engagement with ideas and issues related to the major.
- 2) Explore, connect, and apply a variety of disciplinary approaches to the study of the major.
- 3) Create written arguments based upon the presentation of evidence and analysis.

Two additional, more specific, learning goals will be submitted with the student interdisciplinary major proposal.
