

## 2026-27 Tuition and Fee Overview

The tuition and fees below reflect the full-time cost for the 2026-2027 academic year (Fall '26 and Spring '27).

- Full-time undergraduate tuition: \$40,572

### Student Fees:

- Student Activity Fee: \$200
- Student Technology Fee: \$350

The student activity fee supports Hendrix College Student Association programs and organizations. The student technology fee helps fund cybersecurity, networking, wireless, IT support, and other technology services.

### Board Plans:

- Board Unlimited Plan (includes limited dining dollars): \$7,600
- Board 10-Meal Plan: \$4,600
- Board 85-block Meal Plan: \$2,500
- Community Plan: \$100

Reminder: All undergraduate residential students except those that reside in a Hendrix Apartment are required to be on the Unlimited Plan. All Hendrix Apartment residents must choose between the Unlimited Plan, 10-Meal Plan, or 85-Block Plan. The Community Plan is required for all Commuters if they have not selected another meal plan. The Community Plan provides three on-campus meals per semester for working and eating with your classmates on projects or activities.

### Housing Options:

- Raney, Hardin, Couch – Double: \$7,300
- Raney, Hardin, Couch – Double as a Single: \$9,330
- Residence Houses, Galloway, Miller, MSS, Martin and Veasey – Double: \$8,130
- Residence Houses, Galloway, Miller, MSS, Martin and Veasey – Double as Single: \$10,238
- Theme House – Double: \$7,998

### Apartments:

- Front, Huntington, and Clifton – Double: \$10,573
- Front, Huntington, and Clifton – Triple: \$9,446
- Village and Corner – Double: \$11,610
- Village and Corner – Triple: \$10,380

### Other Tuition:

- Summer Tuition (1 course): \$1,600
- Part-time Tuition (1 course): \$4,900
- Fifth Course: \$2,500
