

June 13-25, 2021 Applications due April 2, 2021

The Hendrix Youth Institute (HYI) is a two-week program that creates learning, mission, and communitybuilding experiences for rising high school who are exploring a call to ministry in the Methodist Church, and specifically introduces participants to ordained and professional ministry. Using a holistic approach, the program incorporates the "head, heart, and hands" to enable youth to understand God's call.

The HYI experience typically includes:

- Two morning classes relating to the Institute's yearly theme, "Bible" and "Wesleyan Studies."
- Afternoons engaged in service work or shadowing church professionals.
- Worship, small groups Bible study, spiritual gift/discernment exercises, and time for fun and fellowship.

• An Orientation to Ministry event sponsored by the Arkansas Conference Board of Ordained Ministry.

• A mission and service learning trip to relevant cities and historical sites in Alabama, Mississippi and Arkansas. The trip's focus is civil rights history, racial justice conversations, and mission work in which participants will work together, building relationships with those they encounter. More details to come.

The only cost to participants is a \$100 refundable deposit to hold your spot (we will not deposit the check).

<u>HYI 2021</u>

Decisions will be ongoing about the themes and structure of the 2021 program, but <u>there will be a</u> <u>Hendrix Youth Institute in 2021</u> between the dates of June 13-25; most likely a hybrid in-person and virtual format. As we continue to navigate the pandemic, we will make decisions based on protocols and guidelines from federal and state public health officials, the Arkansas Conference of the UMC, and Hendrix College. As an applicant, you commit to staying informed and following the protocol that we determine is best for the safety of each individual and the group as a whole. We will be in touch with applicants and parents via email and also update our website as we know and plan further.

HYI participants will also attend a winter reunion retreat in Little Rock on January 14-15, 2022 that includes a service project and time of reflection.
