

Well-Being Community 2022-2023 Call for Applications: Program Leaders

General overview:

Dr. Kennedy and Dean Wiltgen are looking for **two** students to serve as Program Leaders for the 2022-2023 Well-Being Community. Program Leaders will be expected to:

- Live in Market Square South
- Attend weekly Common Hour meetings each semester (4:10-5:00 on Wednesday)
- Assist Dr. Kennedy and Dean Wiltgen in planning and delivering well-being programming for the Well-Being Community and the broader campus community.

Qualifications:

Strong applicants will be able to demonstrate good organizational and team management skills and a commitment to promoting and practicing well-being. Program Leaders will be expected to model and encourage individual responsibility and respect for others. Although this is not a resident assistant position, those selected will also receive training to assist and carry out specific duties for the Well-Being Community in partnership with the Office of Residence Life.

Benefits:

In addition to learning more about the science and practice of well-being, Program Leaders will receive a stipend and be eligible to earn PL Odyssey credit for their efforts. Failure to carry out the responsibilities or meet the expectations of the position may result in dismissal and/or reduction of stipend.

Application process:

Interested individuals should submit a personal statement that answers to the following questions:

- 1. What does well-being mean to you?
- 2. In what ways is your commitment to well-being reflected in your past or current work and/or your future career plans?
- 3. In what ways do you feel you can serve as a positive role model and advocate for well-being on our campus?
- 4. What other time commitments do you expect to have next academic year? (e.g., membership or leadership in student organizations; internships; study abroad; etc.)
- 5. What strengths would you bring to this leadership role?
- 6. What concerns do you have about your ability to serve in this leadership role? (e.g., available time; experience level; etc.)

Please submit your statement via email to Dr. Kennedy <u>and</u> Dean Wiltgen with the subject line, "Program Leader Application." **Applications are due by 11:59PM on Friday, March 18, 2022.** Results of the review process will be shared with applicants no later than <u>5:00PM on Friday, April 1, 2022.</u>
