- 1. Call to Order (7:02 p.m.) with Introductions.
- 2. Attendance taken by Secretary/Treasurer.
- 3. Last meeting's minutes (Apr 2nd) approved.
- 4. Report by the ECC Chair
 - a. Our new executives are:

 - i. Trashion Show is canceled due to lack of participants. Recycle Palooza is being moved to Thursday.
 - ii. Those wishing to help set-up the big Earth Day Celebration should meet in the Burrow at 2:00 p.m. on Apr 24^{th} (Friday). Set-up will take place from 2:00-3:00 p.m. at the Bailey Lawn.

- 5. Report by ECC Vice-Chair, Campaigns
 - a. Regional Haze Hearing in North Little Rock.
 - i. Hanna testified before the panel.
- 6. Report by ECC Vice-Chair, Programs
 - a. Glass recycling issues.
 - i. Glass bins at the Hendrix Corner were stolen this week. Three bins from Conway Sanitation and one bin from us (ECC) have been stolen in total.



- ii. One of these bins turned out to be at Eco House being used as a glass bin for the house. It is being returned to in front of Huntington.
- b. Eight problems with glass recycling and a solution.
 - i. Bins have been stolen because they are small.
 - ii. Small bins lack a lid, which facilities dislikes because they don't look nice.
 - iii. Demand exceeds capacity (as evidenced by the need for additional bins at the apartments.
 - iv. Faith wants more hours, but currently the amount of work required takes only an hour a week.
 - v. Conway Sanitation (CS) will not give us larger glass recycling bins.
 - vi. CS does not empty the small blue bins regularly, despite what their schedule says.
 - vii. Glass recycling in the apartments requires student volunteers to place the bins out for pick-up.
 - viii. Facilities at Hendrix possess large blue recycling bins owned by the city of Conway, but they do not use them.
 - ix. William's solution is to remove all the small bins and replace them with one large bin at each of the apartments (excluding Market Square). Then, to ask that CS stop picking up glass from the apartments and transferring that responsibility to Faith, ensuring that it is picked-up and giving Faith additional hours.
- c. Highway Clean-Up with Student Senate is Apr 25th (Saturday) at 8:00 a.m. Our contact in Senate for those looking to sign-up has yet to be determined.
- d. The ECC and VAC will be picking-up litter at the Hendrix Creek Preserve May 2nd (Saturday). The time has yet to be determined.
